INTRODUCTION

Handloom Foundation was founded by some educated and dedicated social workers with a view to develop the status of the Handloom Industry and also to provide necessary help and assistance to the people associated with Handloom. Besides that the organization is also engaged with several activities that are beneficial for the society and the common people. The organization is playing an important role for the upgradation of Handloom Industry and improving the livelihood of the people associated with it. The organization is registered under Indian Trust Act, 1882 as amended. The motto of the organization is "Promoting Sustainability for a Better World".

VISION AND MISSION STATEMENT

Handloom Foundation envisages that Handloom becoming bigger industry in India and people who are associated with it has their livelihood improved. There will not be difference on nationality, religion, sex, color, rich and poor in the society. Human equality as mutual dignity, love, respect, sincerity, correctness and self-confidence will be maintained and local destroyed culture should be revived.

To achieve its goal it has and will undertake programmes and projects for creating awareness on Importance of Indian Handloom in terms of climate resilience, Public Health and employment generation. Besides that it has and will also work for Relief of the Poor, Elimination of Child Labour, Sanitation and Rural Health, Education for the downtrodden and poor, advancement of literary, culture, scientific and technical education, vocational training programme for the youths, gymnasium programme, children and women, welfare programmes for the aged, sick, destitute and undertaken programmes for the welfare of disabled persons and other various programmes as the society needs.

OPERATIONAL AREA

The organization is at present working at backward areas and villages in the district of South 24 Parganas in West Bengal and also several other nearby districts. The areas where we focus is definitely a backward region in the state, where majority of the population doesn't have proper income and depends on handloom, agriculture etc. for their livelihood.



TARGET GROUPS

Underprivileged, economically backward section of the society with the priority to the destitute women and distressed children, older persons, disabled persons and students are the target groups of Ava National Charitable Trust. During the year 2020-21, the organisation has covered 1600+ poor people through its multifarious development activities.

ORGANOGRAM OF THE ORGANISATION

HF (Handloom Foundation), is governed, managed and controlled by an executive committee consisting of two executive members including one women member and several volunteers across the nation. It is managed by a team of experts comprising professionals from different sections of the society engaged in planning, coordination and implementation of various programs and communicate with various agencies related to the respective programs. The members of the executive committee are elected by the general members in the annual general meeting every year. The governing body then selects its office bearer's i.e. key signatories. The secretary has the role and function in all the affairs viz. daily routine work, administration, policy, finance, and strategies and in statutory works. The governing body sits together once in two months to make the policy and the strategies including financial and statutory works to implement its welfare activities successfully.

POLICY INITIATIVE

The organisation has given top priority on sustainable development through people's participation for creation of a permanent institution which will keep its eyes on all round development of the rural poor people. The goal is to create a revolving fund by formation of a large number of self-help groups and collection of regular savings for self-reliance, self-sufficiency and empowerment of the rural poor people.

MAN POWER


The organisation has already got sufficient qualified, trained and experienced man power who are quite capable of implementing different social welfare and community development programs.

2. SUPPORT TO ARTISANS AND THEIR FAMILIES

During the year 2021-22 Financial Year, we have provided help and support to 25 Artisan Families. Due to the wave and rise of COVID-19 Pandemic the Artisans left weaving as they were getting less orders and also bearing losses which they can't afford. Our organization helped them get back their livelihood by getting them orders from various clients.





3. MUSLIN JAMDANI REVIVAL PROJECT

Many textile traditions of our country as well as our state is becoming obsolete due to western approach. There are number of factors leading to the decline of Jamdani including cheaper yarn import from Europe which is not quality wise as good as Jamdani but very cheap. Another reason is that the artisans in this sector doesn't earn much. Therefore, we have started the "Muslin Jamdani Revival Project" this year. We have helped many artisans under the project and addressed their problems and helped them making more sales. We have also made videos on myths and misconceptions and facts about Jamdani and Muslin in our YouTube channel to help people clear their myths and know some unknown facts about it. 


4. PUBLISHING BOOK
